The seminar will introduce to the students several theoretical and practical interpretations of the industrial legacy on its path toward patrimonial acknowledgement, either in a topdown or bottom-up approach at international in the last forty years. Thus, it will bring into debate the topic of dissonant and toxic built legacies in direct references to the tangible and intangible manifestations of the post-industrial landscapes, and the approached methods used by various actors (i.e., scholars, heritage professionals, planners, architects, local community, activists, etc.) will pushing towards their documentation, safeguarding, and enhancement as cultural heritage. Furthermore, it will be investigated the conceptual transformation of the cultural landscape in relation to the mining legacies and their methodological approach within the patrimonial acknowledgement, stressing the role that the UNESCO label can play while negotiating at local and regional level such aspects of the multi-scale territorial legacies in a
